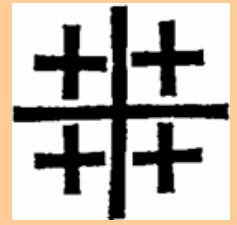

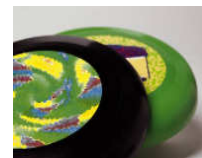
Sunday Night W A Y**Sundays 6:30-8:30pm**
